VIII.	Your rights as the party concerned

	 You may withdraw your consent that was given to us at any time (Article 7(3) of the GDPR). This, on the other hand, can lead to the result that you are no longer permitted to enter our plant premises in Hamburg.
	You have the right to request information regarding your personal data that is saved and processed by us (Article 15 of the GDPR).
